LOCATION	Togwotee Mountain Lodge and Togwotee Snowmobile Adventures offer some of the best snowmobile adventures in the world's premier snowmobiling destination. Togwotee Mountain Lodge is located near Togwotee Pass within the Bridger-Teton National Forest, just a short, beautiful ride through the woods rising above Jackson Hole and very convenient to Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks. Togwotee Snowmobile Adventures is located at 1450 S. Hwy 89 and 110 W. Broadway in Jackson Hole, Wyoming.

OVERVIEW	<p>Togwotee is known as a premier snowmobiling destination with around 2.5 million acres of off-trail riding opportunities and access to 600 miles of groomed trails right outside the front door. At 8600 ft above sea level, Togwotee is ideally situated on the western flank of the Continental Divide. Not only does Togwotee get an average of 600 inches of snow every year but also the conditions are ideal due to the light, fluffy and deep snow that covers the area.</p> <p>Togwotee Mountain Lodge is located on the Continental Divide Snowmobile Trail System (CDST) with access to 600 miles of groomed trails and 2.5million acres of off trail riding opportunities. The CDST is a world-class snowmobile destination for deep powder off trail snowmobiling. The CDST has been rated as one of the top two destinations in the West for an over all riding experience by SnoWest Readers in the Western Guide to Snowmobiling.</p> <p>Togwotee Mountain Lodge operates the largest snowmobile fleet in North America. A variety of experiences are offered from trail riding for beginners to off trail backcountry riding for expert and extreme snowmobilers. Togwotee Mountain Lodge is committed to changing out the entire fleet every year to ensure guests enjoy the most recent in snowmobile technology and safety providing Togwotee's guests a premium snowmobiling experience.</p>
AVAILABLE TOURS	Yellowstone Snowmobiling Tours



The Old Faithful Tour – A classic adventure that takes you into Yellowstone National Park. Guests are picked up at their hotel and provided hot buffet breakfast.

- 90-mile round trip
- Departs daily at from December through April
- A hot grill lunch at the geyser
- All rates include transportation to location, helmet, snowmobile, and guide

The Canyons Tour – This tour enters at the south entrance of Yellowstone traveling up to the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone along the eastern roads of the park. This tour does not visit Old Faithful. Guests enjoy a picnic lunch at the canyons and travel back to the south gate. The canyon is estimated to be 10,000 years old, 20 miles long, 1000 ft deep, and 2500 ft wide. The Yellowstone river, upper falls, and lower falls, have shaped the canyon over thousands of years providing the landscape that is used by many artists as their inspiration.

- 125-mile round trip
- Picnic lunch at the canyons
- Not recommended for elderly double riders

The Yellowstone Loop Tour – This tour enters from the south entrance of Yellowstone and travels up to the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone on the eastern roads of the park. After a short stop at the Canyon continue on the lower loop of the park to Old Faithful.

- 170-mile round trip
- For single riders only and not recommended for the elderly or infirm

National Forest Snowmobiling Tours

These are offered through our sister company Togwotee Snowmobiling Adventures in Jackson, Wyoming. The options are listed below and are suited best for guests staying in Jackson.

Granite Hot Springs Snowmobile Tours - A unique snowmobiling tour that provides snowmobilers with a hot soak at their destination alongside a freshly prepared salmon or steak lunch.

- Tour meets in Jackson and travels 40 minutes south of Jackson to the snowmobile location
- 30-mile round trip

Gros Venture Tour Snowmobile Tours - located a few miles north of Jackson and travels into the Gros Venture river drainage on the Continental Divide Trail system.

Togwotee Day Tour Snowmobile Tour - A perfect destination snowmobile trip outside of Yellowstone National Park. Guests are picked up at their hotel in Jackson, provided breakfast in Jackson and then transported to Togwotee Mountain Lodge.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Togwotee remains uncongested with only about 300 people per day in the vast 2.5 million acres riding area, compared to as many as 3000 people at West Yellowstone with a riding area of only 700,000 acres.
- The entire state of Delaware can fit in the snowmobiling riding area of 2.5 million acres at Togwotee
- You can ride 170 SE and never cross a highway
- 24 inches of snow = 1 inch of water
- The 2007 winter season experienced over 600 inches of snow
- 600 inches of annual snowfall is the height of 5 basketball hoops
- Wyoming has a greater population of antelope than people
- At 8564 ft, Togwotee's elevation is equal to height of nearly seven Empire State Buildings
